BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEMBERS TO BE ELECTED - During the December 7th Oak Ridge Chamber of Commerce Holiday Reception & Annual Meeting, the membership will vote on new board members to take office on January 1, 2005 and serve for four years. Six individuals have agreed to serve if elected by the membership. The slate of nominees was developed by the Chamber's Nominating Committee and was endorsed by the Board of Directors. The six individuals to be presented for election are: **Barry Goss** of Pro2Serve; **Mark Harvey** of The Cowperwood Company; **Donna Powers** of Realty 100, Inc.; **Dave Mason** of USEC; **Jan McNally** of Methodist Medical Center; and **Phil Andrews** of Boeing-Oak Ridge. McNally and Andrews have been serving on the Chamber's Board of Directors in recent years completing unexpired terms of board members who resigned their positions. Both McNally and Andrews were eligible for re-election to four-year terms of office. A seventh board seat will remain unfilled until the Chamber's Program of Work Kickoff Breakfast in January.

BUSINESS-TO-BUSINESS EXPO A SUCCESS - With eighty-five exhibitors, nearly 250 people attending the luncheon and hundreds of visitors, the 3rd Annual Business-to-Business Expo was a tremendous success. A special thank you to the many businesses who contributed to the event's success.

CONGRATULATIONS TO USEC, BOEING AND HONEYWELL - On October 27th, a significant economic development announcement was made by USEC regarding the American Centrifuge Program. A partnership formed between USEC, Boeing and Honeywell will result in a significant capital investment in Oak Ridge in the coming years and will create hundreds of new jobs. The Chamber's economic development corporation, the Oak Ridge Economic Partnership, the East Tennessee Economic Council and the City of Oak Ridge facilitated the details associated with this financial investment and new job creation in Oak Ridge.
